Things you should know about your non-potable water system:

- 1. Stay out of the District's meter pit.
- 2. You must know where your shut off valve is. It is not in the District meter pit.
- 3. Make sure you have the correct valve key if one is needed to turn off your shut-off valve.

The older Filing 1 with Phases 1, 2 & 3: some homes had a round metal cap or metal wheeled sprocket and you had to use a valve key to open and close the valve. If you have this type, you should replace it.

Last year a homeowner could not find there shut off value, the District had to turn off the whole zone for 5 days so this person could find and fix shut off valve, leaving that whole block without non-potable water.

- 4. You should have a rain sensor installed and set at ½ inch to ¾ inch of rain.
- 5. You should have an inline filter installed.
- 6. Irrigation heads should be cleaned several times a year or as needed.
- 7. You have your irrigation clock turned on and set to water at the same time as the watering schedule for your area.
- 8. Check your irrigation clock for correct time, am and pm, and have set the correct year on your irrigation clock.
- 9. Check back up battery supply.
- 10. Google or go to manufactures web site to learn how to operate your irrigation clock.
- 11. Non-potable water system shuts down on the 3rd Friday of October, see the winterization schedule.
