Non-Potable Water System Winterization Schedule

The non-potable water system will be turned off on October 25, 2024 to prepare for the blow out of the system on Saturday, October 26, 2024.

To winterize the non-potable water system on Saturday, October 26 water to the non-potable water system will be turned off on Friday, October 25. This way Foothills Landscape Maintenance can hook up air compressors, open and close certain values to accomplish this blow out on such a large system.

This scheduled blow out of the non-potable water system is your chance to blow out <u>your privately</u>owned irrigation system, while the District blows out the Districts main lines.

- 1. Before the main line blow out: <u>Clean your inline filter if you have one</u>, if you don't you should install one before next year. Also find your irrigation shut off valve, make sure you know the location. <u>Turn</u> off your irrigation valve after blow out.
- 2. Set your irrigation clock during the scheduled time for your color-coded area on the map below.
- 3. DO NOT START YOUR CLOCK BEFORE YOUR START TIME.
- 4. Set your irrigation clock to blow out each zone on your system for about 3 to 4 minutes, or until you see no more water coming out of the irrigation heads.
- 5. After you blow out your irrigation system turn off your ball valve which is in your irrigation box.
- 6. If you do not have an in-line ball valve you should have one installed. Do not go into District meter pit.
- 7. Disclaimer: Your home irrigation is privately owned by you, and you are responsible for the maintenance and the winterization (blow out) of your own irrigation system. The District only blows out the main line non-potable water system. If you are unable to blow out your system the day the District conducts its blow out, you will have to set up your own irrigation system winterization.
- 8. This is a good day to clean your inline water filters and irrigation heads. Inline water filters and irrigation heads should be cleaned several times a year. If you do not have an inline filter, you have one installed along with a blowout/drain connection. Make sure you know where your shut off valve is located and how to turn it off. As always, please stay out of the District meter pits.
